

## GACC Officers and Board Members Election – October Update

*Normally*, at the October GACC General Meeting, we would present a slate of candidates to the Council and take any other nominations from the floor to add to the slate. No more nominations are allowed after the October meeting is over. However, 2020 has been anything but *normal*. [On October 7<sup>th</sup>](#), the first Wednesday in October, when we would *normally* be having our General Meeting, the University of Utah is hosting the only national Vice-President Debate between current VP Mike Pense and Sen. Kamala Harris. Because of the interest surrounding this debate, the GACC Board decided that our elections could not be *normal* and voted to make a change for this year only. Our [October 7<sup>th</sup>](#) GACC General Meeting is canceled.

Instead of presenting a slate and then getting nominations from the floor [on October 7<sup>th</sup>](#), we will present the slate on our website [slc-avenues.org](http://slc-avenues.org) on October 1<sup>st</sup>. We need names and contact information. The slate of candidates on the website will then be amended with those new names added. This slate will be listed on the website and in the November *Agenda* just like it would have been done *normally*.
