

Popperton Park Trails

Salt Lake City's Foothills Trail System will begin construction this summer starting with improvements to Popperton Park. Pedestrian trails should begin being built this summer with bike trails to come later in the fall or spring. See map on the alternate side for a layout of this trail system.

From 2016-2018, SLC Trails and Natural Lands conducted vast public engagement efforts to receive community feedback for the Foothills Trail System Master Plan. While the trails in Popperton Park are not precisely the same as those drafted in the initial plan, the quantity and distribution between hiking and biking trails remain consistent.

Experienced local trail builder Creative Trails was awarded the Popperton Park project this spring and has brought their expertise in sustainable and safe trail design to this property. As part of the master plan, certain unsustainable user-created social trails will be decommissioned (closed to allow return to natural state.) As trails are completed, we will install wayfinding signage and communicate the trails' opening to the public for your enjoyment.
